THE SOLUTION

Working alongside the investment of WSU, the city and federal government into the 67214 zip code, we wish to address the needs of returning persons to this area, so that this investment product is kept intact, and lives can be transformed.

Using the successful re-entry model of Working Men of Christ reentry ministry (recidivism rate of 5% over nine years), we offer stable housing (2 houses), faith-based, highly structured community, high accountability, practical support and employment help. Each house will house ten persons, and two administrators.
